 Is there a way to do the security piece without the new office piece?

This project is centered around having the people at the front of the building to control access (who is coming or going.) Relocating the main offices to the front of the building is a key piece of this security upgrade.

- What is the tax increase? \$69.00/year based on a \$200,000 home in Monroe.
- Why can't we have an armed school resource officer instead? Current events have shown us that this is not a solution to preventing school violence. In hiring an SRO, the District would likely be looking at a candidate pool that has not necessarily completed law enforcement training. This person would be placed on the salary schedule and would receive a yearly salary as well as benefits.


