Any senior attending Blue Mountain Union 21, St. Johnsbury Academy, Danville High School or Woodsville High School and residing in either BARNET, RYEGATE, or MONROE may apply for the award. Also, the applicant must have attended one of these schools for the last two years.

Any qualified senior should submit to the awards committee:

- 1. A copy of his/her transcript from his/her school.
- 2. A one-page letter FROM THE STUDENT telling of his/her future plans and the college

he/she plans to attend

- 3. Two letters from teachers or guidance directors concerning the applicant.
- 4. A copy of your letter of acceptance from the college you plan to attend.

The recipient will be announced at the time of graduation.

Payment of the award will be made in August. If it is a four-year college, four equal payments will be made, one for each year he/she attends. A two-year college will be made in two equal payments. If the recipient of the award drops out of school and is out more than one year, the balance of the award will be forfeited, unless prior arrangements are made with the awards committee.
