PLANNING BOARD

Business Owners

In March, 2017 the residents of Monroe voted by ballot to enable Site Plan Review in accordance with state statutes. This September, the Monroe Planning Board approved Site Plan Review Regulations for non-residential and multi-family development in our community. Using public input from the town Master Plan as a guide, the Board worked with residents and business owners to provide sensible Site Plan Review Regulations which maintain the rural character of the community.

What does this mean for a business? Before any Zoning "Building" Permit can be issued, the proposed activity must go through Site Plan Review by the Planning Board. The Site Plan Review Regulations include the following standards for nonresidential or multifamily development, redevelopment, expansion, or for changes from one such use to another:

- Building appearance
- Vehicle and pedestrian safety
- Parking space requirements
- Landscaping and screening
- Storm water
- Snow storage
- Utilities
- Outdoor lighting
- Signs
- Natural Features
- Fire Protection

It is important for businesses to be aware of the new regulations and the time frames involved. We encourage you to download a copy of the Site Plan Review Regulations at: monroenh.org/forms.php or stop by the Town Office to pick up a copy.
