MNUTES

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Oren Remick.

Selectmen Present: John Blanchard, Justin Bradshaw, Oren Remick

Public Present: Woody Woodworth, Myrna Woodworth

1. Approval of the minutes from 5/25/2021 Selectmen Meeting. Oren moved and John seconded to approve the minutes of the 5/25/2021 Selectmen Meeting as written. The motion carried unanimously.
2. Public Input - none
3. Discussion Items.
 - a. Justin stated pump #2 is working but it appears the meter is not registering. Will be looked at and may need to have the meter replaced.
 - b. Diane requested clarification on the extra work we are requesting Northwoods Excavating to do. After discussion, the decision was to have up to 1000 ft of road fixed in preparation of paving. This will be from Huntoon's to the top of the hill.
 - c. Projects
 - i. Town hall mats – no update.
 - ii. Security cameras – proposals have been reviewed and are still valid. Oren moved and John seconded to approve using Round Hill Fence and Security to install the new cameras at the Municipal Building and to provide the security/monitoring at the Municipal Building.
 - iii. Concrete work – no update.
 - iv. Hazardous Waste Day – no update.

- d. A private road is being put in off Lang Road. The Road Agent needs to look at the road to make sure it meets the Town's specifications. Randy Bunnell has looked at the road and verbally approved it. Diane will put together a letter for the Planning file regarding this. A second letter will be needed when the road is named.
- e. John stated we need to get some type of gate or fence around the tires. After discussion, the decision was made to put up a cable covering the entrance. John moved to approve and Oren seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.
- f. John stated there is one more tree to come on the line between Powers and the Municipal Building. Will see if this can be done.
- g. Crack sealing of roads was discussed. The decision was to hold off for right now.
- h. Justin stated the School has requested to use the arbor at the Town Hall for graduation. The Selectmen approved its usage.

4. The following items were approved – none submitted.

Oren moved to adjourn the meeting and John seconded the motion. The meeting adjourned at 8:30 p.m.
