## MNUTES

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Oren Remick.

Selectmen Present: John Blanchard, Justin Bradshaw, Oren Remick

Public Present: Linda Hall, Library Trustee

1. Approval of the minutes from 6/08/2021 Selectmen Meeting. Oren moved and Justin seconded to approve the minutes of the 6/08/2021 Selectmen Meeting as written. The motion carried unanimously.
2. Public Input
  - a. Linda requested to have the electronic speed sign set out on Saturday, June 26<sup>th</sup> for the Town-wide yard sale.
  - b. Linda distributed copies of the Memorandum of Understanding for the Library. She stated the facilities maintenance employee is easy to work with and does a great job. There is an issue though with the front of the library and the boundary with the neighbor. After discussion of the issues, the decision was made to have the boundary line surveyed. The Selectmen also noted the facilities maintenance employee should have checked with the Library Trustees prior to making several changes.
3. Discussion Items.
  - a. Fence proposals opening. One proposal was received for the fencing at the Municipal Building. After reviewing the proposal, the Selectmen decided to reject it and to look at alternate solutions.

- b. Proposed turnaround on Smutty Hollow. The landowner was contacted regarding the proposed turnaround on Smutty Hollow and has said no. The town will now look at the area to see if another spot can be used.

Justin left the room due to a conflict of interest.

- c. Abatement issue with Great River Hydro. John and Oren reviewed the letter received from our utility appraiser George Sansoucy. The decision was made to deny the abatement request by Great River Hydro based on the recommendation made by George Sansoucy. John moved to deny the request for the abatement and Oren seconded the motion. The motion carried. The denial will be sent out on Wednesday, June 16<sup>th</sup>.

Justin returned to the meeting.

- d. Justin asked if the Coppermine Road was complete. The culvert project is complete and the rebuilding of the road from Huntoon's to Lapierre's is also complete. Will need to put a bid package together for paving Coppermine Road.

Justin suggested having the facilities maintenance employee and the road agent start coming in to meetings once a month to discuss projects.

- e. Issue with dumpster at the Municipal Building. There is an issue with people placing weekly trash in the dumpster at the Municipal Building. The dumpster is there to be used by the Municipal Building and for the use of a few people who cannot leave trash at the roadside due to safety reasons. The dumpster will be moved and made less available.

4. The following item was approved.

- a. Report of Cut Timber

Oren moved to adjourn the meeting and John seconded the motion. The meeting adjourned at 8:50 p.m.
