MINUTES

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by John Blanchard.

Selectmen Present: John Blanchard, Justin Bradshaw

Public Present: Keith Merchand, Stephanie Brousseau, Joseph Beaulieu

1. Approval of the minutes from 7/20/2021 Selectmen Meeting. The minutes will be brought forward for approval when Oren Remick is back.
2. Public Input
  - a. Edward Lenig brought in a building permit for approval. The permit was approved.
  - b. Keith noted the mowing at the North Monroe Fire Station seem to be out a bit far. The lot is only 100 x 50.
3. Discussion items
  - a. The paving of Coppermine Road was discussed. Clarification on wording will be needed before going ahead with the paving.
  - b. A request for information about property on Coppermine Road was received. Tiny homes are not regulated within the Town of Monroe. Camping guidelines currently follow State rules. Camping is being looked into by the Planning Department for a possible revision to the Zoning Ordinance next year.
  - c. John had several items to discuss
    - i. New Cameras at the Municipal Building- contract was signed. Will check on when being installed.

- ii. Heating Shack at the skating rink. Will be looking into a gas heater and a small hot water heater. Will contact propane company regarding the hook-ups.
  - iii. North Monroe Cemetery additional plots – the road will be built all the way around the new section to allow for parking during services. The road will be 11 foot wide and a gate will be added that is 13.5 ft wide. Paths will be 10 ft wide grass areas to allow vault trucks access to all burial lots. Full burial lots will be 8 x 10 two-person lots. Cremation lots will be 8 x 6 lots. All stones will be on the upper side with the heads of the vaults being uphill. New rules and regulations will be put together for these lots.
- d. Welcome Letter – several minor changes were requested. Final approval will be done once all Selectmen are back.

4. The following item was approved:

- a. Accounts Payable Manifest – General Fund

John moved to adjourn the meeting and Justin seconded the motion. The meeting adjourned at 8:30p.m.
