Selectmen Meeting Minutes
February 9, 2021

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Oren Remick.

Selectmen Present: John Blanchard, Justin Bradshaw, Oren Remick

Public Present: Dick Blanchard, PJ Blanchard

1. Approval of the minutes from 2/2/21 Budget Hearing and 2/2/21 Selectmen Meeting. Oren moved and John seconded to approve the minutes of 02/02/21 Budget Hearing and 2//02/21 Selectmen's Meeting. The motion carried unanimously.
2. Public Input
 - a. Dick Blanchard turned in a driveway permit. He also asked questions regarding a septic system that is currently in place on the property. The driveway permit will be reviewed by Road Agent Bunnell prior to coming back for approval. Justin will contact the State regarding the septic system questions.
 - b. PJ Blanchard again stated his concerns about paying the Planning Board. Justin noted that this has been put into warrant articles to be decided at the Town Meeting. The idea now is to pay to Planning Board Chair a set stipend and to pay the Planning Board members once a year based on the number of meetings attended either virtually or in person.

3. Discussion items

- a. Diane requested an item the school brought over be reviewed and discussed. After reviewing the item, the decision was to have our Assessor look at this and make a determination regarding the ownership of the property.
- b. Justin stated aeration is still being reported in the water system. Thursday a plumber will be fixing a pump valve. Will see if the aeration is eliminated once the system is back to fully functional.
- c. Tree Bid – this was discussed. The remaining trees to be cut will be marked soon but the trees behind the Town Office will not be included.
- d. Newsletter item – Coppermine Project – pre-bid meeting is on 2/22 at 10:30. A list of items is being put together to discuss.
- e. Fire System - batteries will be replaced on Friday at 9:00.
- f. New Security System at the Municipal Building – still working on this project
- g. Skidder going on Stanton Road – person has been spoken to about this.
- h. John stated Mr. Colpitts questioned the skating rink again. Perhaps a smaller hose can be used to flood the rink.
- i. Justin stated he has checked into an energy audit program from Liberty Utilities. Will explore this before making a decision on the boiler at the Municipal Building.

4. No items item(s) were submitted for approval.

Oren moved to adjourn the meeting and John seconded the motion. The meeting adjourned at 8:50 p.m.
