May 5, 2020

1. State Representative Tim Egan called in and updated the Selectmen on what was going on in the State. Items currently being worked on in the State include a Timber Harvest webinar, rural wifi (a committee has been put together), and cooperative advertising. Justin asked about the recently announced government funding being offered to the towns and how the funds can be used. Representative Egan stated the money can be used for personal protection equipment, wages, etc. He suggested putting a list of possible expenditures together. More information will be forthcoming.
2. Approved Minutes from April 28, 2020. Oren moved and Justin seconded to approve the April 28, 2020 minutes. The motion carried unanimously.

7. Diane asked about the bid for the paving. Decision was made to hold off on the bid for paving until all the culvert replacements are completed. Also the decision was made to not pave under the new Storage Building at this time and to see how it works out with no paving.
8. Diane stated she had information on health plans to be reviewed at the next meeting.
9. The following item was approved.

  - b. Report of Wood or Timber Cut – Richard Johnson
  - c. Pistol permit – PJ Blanchard
10. Diane stated she had spoken to people at Pete’s Rubbish who said they would like to do 2 weekends of Large Trash. After discussion, the decision was made to continue with June 13<sup>th</sup> only but to possibly add an additional dumpster.

Oren moved to adjourn the meeting and John seconded the motion. The meeting adjourned at 8:58 p.m.
