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Selectmen Meeting Minutes
June 2, 2020

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Oren Remick.

Selectmen Present: John Blanchard, Justin Bradshaw, Oren Remick

Public Present: Chad and Olivia Grant, Merle Jones

1. Approved Minutes from May 26, 2020. Justin moved and Oren seconded to approve the May 26, 2020 minutes. The motion carried unanimously.
2. Public input
 - a. Chad Grant asked about possibly purchasing the property at 1 Main Street. Justin stated the sale would require approval at the Town Meeting and then it would need to go out for sealed bid. The suggestion was made to put a petition together to add this item to the Warrant for next year.
3. Updates on COVID 19. Grant documents were submitted. Town Office and Municipal Building are open. Town office has masks and hand sanitizer available when you enter. Town Clerk will continue shortened hours for a few more weeks. Town Hall is closed for flooring project.
4. Off Highway Recreational Vehicle Policy (OHRV) – feedback received. Merle Jones requested a hard copy of the policy to review. Feedback was received from several citizens. After discussion the determination was made to review the parking part of the policy and to change it to state to parking on the sides of the road or on Town property. Also the enforcement needs to be looked at more fully. Was also decided that when the policy is completed, a public meeting will be held to accept all portions of the policy.

5. Bids on items – No bids were received.
6. Diane stated the Town Clerk received an email from Great River Hydro LLC regarding the tax agreement which has expired. Oren moved to have George Sansoucy's company work on renewing the agreement and John seconded the motion. Oren and John voted to accept the motion. Justin abstained from voting. The motion carried.
7. Justin stated he has some additional information on Recycling. A meeting with the committee will be scheduled in the near future.
8. The following items were approved.
 - a. Accounts Payable Manifest – for Water and General Fund
 - b. Report of Wood/Timber Cut for Peter Stanton
 - c. Use of Town Hall for October 9, 10, 11
9. A building permit was submitted for land on Plains Road. This permit needs to have additional information before it can be considered.

Justin moved to adjourn the meeting and John seconded the motion. The meeting adjourned at 9:00 p.m.
