Selectmen Meeting Minutes
September 8, 2020

The meeting was called to order at 7:08 p.m. by Oren Remick.

Selectmen Present: John Blanchard, Justin Bradshaw, Oren Remick

Public Present: Harold "Woody" Woodworth

1. Public Input

- a. Woody questioned the use of golf carts on roads. Justin stated he has reviewed the Revised Statutes Annotated (RSAs) which seem to indicate they can be used on roads if certain conditions are met. The Board will check with the State Police about the use of golf carts on roads.

2. Discussion items

- a. Coppermine Road project – Justin stated he has been in contact with Jim McMahon. Mr. McMahon sent copies of the permit and correct lengths of the culverts. Diane has sent bid package to be reviewed by our municipal lawyer
- b. North Monroe Cemetery. Justin stated he has spoken with a couple of companies that set up cemeteries. The decision was to work with Horizon's Engineering to set up the new part of the cemetery and to stake out about 250 to 300 plots. The cost will be approximately \$3500. A contract will be brought back.
- c. Crack sealing – both companies are working on sealing cracks on the roads. .
- d. Paving – Stanton Road will be paved soon. Next will look at the Grange Hall Road where it comes out onto Route 135. Will submit the State Driveway permit for that road soon.

- e. Justin stated he had spoken to Kurt Duvall (Maintenance) about several projects. Will look into bidding out cement work at the Town Hall and Post Office next year.
3. Items for approval
- a. Contract with Murray for transportation of recycling.

John moved to adjourn the meeting and Oren seconded the motion. The meeting adjourned at 8:30 p.m.
