



Town of Monroe
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Selectmen Meeting Minutes
October 13, 2020

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Oren Remick.

Selectmen Present: John Blanchard, Justin Bradshaw, Oren Remick

Public Present: Keith Merchand, Woody Woodworh, Julie Hall

1. Lighting Project at the Library. Justin explained we have hired a local electrician to do some work for us. He could also do the Library project and the Library would supply him with the lights. This would guaranty getting the lights that are wanted. Julie Hall and Jessica Sherman (via phone) approved moving in this direction for their project. They will contact the electrician and work directly with him.
2. Approval of the minutes from 10/6/2020. John moved and Oren seconded to approve the minutes of 10/6/2020 Selectmen's meeting as written.
3. Public Input
 - a. Keith presented a request for a raffle permit for the Monroe Men's Club. The Board approved the raffle permit.
4. Update on projects:
 - a. PA system in the Town Hall. Kurt will meet with a person coming up from Portsmouth on Thursday to see what is needed.
 - b. Able Security has provided a name to look into the new camera system for the Municipal Building – Kevin Lufkin. He will contact us when he is able to be here to look at what is needed.

- c. Mats to cover the stage at the Town hall – looking at possibly replacing the mats as the old ones are in terrible shape.
 - d. Codes for the alarm system at the Municipal Building will be redone in the next week or so.
5. Off Highway Recreational Vehicle Policy – the last revision to the policy was done in August. Oren moved and John seconded to adopt the policy. The policy was adopted and will be placed on the website.
6. Tax Millage rate. Diane stated she has received the draft millage rate for the 2021 taxes. Oren moved and John seconded to accept the draft rate as presented. The draft rate was set at \$11.98 per \$1000.
7. The following items were approved
 - a. Payroll Manifest
 - b. Accounts Payable Manifest – General Fund/Water Fund
 - c. Requests for Permanent Property Tax Exemptions for Veterans - 2
 - d. Town Hall Usage Forms – 2
 - e. Final request for reimbursement from GOFFER (COVID-19 expenses reimbursement from State)

John moved to adjourn the meeting and Justin seconded the motion. The meeting adjourned at 9:00 p.m.
